Girls Mission Camp #1 July 4-8

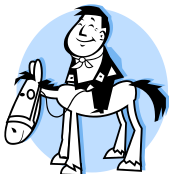

Mission Camp leaves them with memories of swimming, horseback riding, wading in the creek, drama, Bible Study, Missionaries from all over the world, children's worship services, singing and spending the week cabin style.

If you would like for your child to attend camp with us this year, please fill out registration forms (available in the School and Church Office) and return them by Wednesday, April 13, 2011 with \$100.00 deposit (make checks payable to Comite Baptist Church). The total fee for camp is \$210.00 for the week. The additional balance of \$110.00 will be due June 4, 2011.

We will have candle and bulb fund raisers available to the children who would like to raise their \$100.00 deposit. The May 28th Comite Baptist Church Missions Golf Tournament will offer an opportunity for the children to raise funds toward their remaining \$110.00 balance.

If each camper will sale one (\$100) Hole Sponsorship for the Golf Tournament, their camp fee will be covered. It is okay to split the cost for the hole and have more than one sign on the hole.

2011 CHILDREN'S MISSION CAMPS INFORMATION FOR CAMPERS

- 1.) Concessions are included in camp fee. Each afternoon and evening campers are offered a 6 oz. drink and a snack from the concessions. Campers are not allowed to bring candy, food or gum from home.
- 2.) Each camper has the opportunity to bring a missions offering to camp. Place in a sealed envelope marked Missions Offering and turn it in to Ms. Ann the day we leave. **(Do not pack in suitcase)**
- 3.) Each camper is allowed to bring money to spend at the Camp Store for souvenirs, T-shirts, CDs, etc. (Items average \$2.00-\$15.00). Place in sealed envelope marked Camp Store with camper's name. If camper does not spend it, the money will come home with him. **(Do not pack in suitcase)**
- 4.) Any camper medication must be given to Ms. Ann on the day that we leave. Place the medication in a Zip-Lock bag with camper's name on it and each prescription medication in its original bottle. A card will be given to parents at the end of the week showing when the medication was given by the camp nurse. **(Do not pack in suitcase)**
- 5.) Campers are not allowed to call home. Parents may call and check on campers if they feel it is necessary during regular office hours (8:30 am-4:30 pm). If the camper becomes ill or injured parents will be notified. Campers are not allowed to bring cell phones to camp. I will try to let the church offices know how the campers are doing. My cell does not typically work at camp but I will call out from the camp office to keep everyone posted. We are sensitive to those children who are a little homesick, and campers have lots of mom figures at camp. Please do not promise your child you will come get them if they get too homesick. This really hinders their camp experience. Let him know you have confidence in him and he will be so proud of himself once he completes camp.

WHAT EVERY CAMPER NEEDS TO BRING:

- 1.) Sleeping Bag or twin sheets
- 2.) Light Blanket and Pillow (Don't forget your pillow it is the most forgotten item)
- 3.) Towels and face cloth for shower M, T, W, Th night
- 4.) Swim Suit with cover up and towel or two for M, T, W, Th swimming (if two-piece or midriff exposed, girls must wear a dark T-shirt while swimming)
- 5.) Soap, Shampoo
- 6.) Personal grooming items like hairbrush and hair accessories (for girls)
- 7.) Five sets of play clothes (no spaghetti strap shirts) Lots of outdoor play
- 8.) One set of creek clothes including crotch or water shoes (good for hiking to creek and water play)
- 9.) Long pants for evening activities M, T, W, Th (include at least one pair jeans for horseback riding)
- 10.) No excessively tight or short shorts or hot clothing
- 11.) Light Jacket or Windbreaker
- 12.) Bible
- 13.) Flashlight
- 14.) Insect Repellent
- 15.) Rain Slicker or Umbrella
- 16.) Stamps, self-addressed envelopes and paper (for writing home and journaling during rest time)
- 17.) Bandana (to wear under helmet)
- 18.) Disposable camera (optional – be sure to put name on it)
- 19.) Boots for horse riding (optional)
- 20.) If needed: Swimmer's Ear for swimming or any ear plugs needed
- 21.) Comfortable Tennis shoes or Crock shoes for lots of walking and play (no sandals or flip flops)
- 22.) Two large trash bags with campers name taped on them (for wet and dry dirty clothes)
